Day	English	Maths	Topic
Monday	<p>This term our new topic is Bright Lights, Big City, where we will be learning all about London.</p> <p>Listen to the story Katie in London on YouTube https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ImrNxivC9bb4</p> <p>Tell an adult about the story. Where does Katie visit? Who is her tour guide? What places does she visit in London? Would you like to visit London? Where would you like to go?</p> <p>Phonics- Recap all of the phase 3 sounds that we have learnt so far (ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, oo, ar or, ur, ow, ow, oi). Use your orange book to help you and practise reading some of the real and alien words.</p> <p>Spellings- Learn to read and spell the phase 4 tricky words- do, some and come. Can you put these words into a sentence?</p>	<p>Practise counting forwards and backwards to and from 20. These songs will help https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0VLxWIHRD4E https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8hD26XpuUCc</p> <p>Practise counting backwards independently.</p> <p>Order objects from smallest to greatest. See White Rose online teaching video clip. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/week-12-number-place-value-within-20/ Look for ordering objects video.</p> <p>Complete worksheet attached – ordering objects.</p>	<p>Science We have started our new Science topic Everyday Materials. On Monday we learnt about the difference between an object and a material. Remember a material is the name of what an object is made from.</p> <p>Go on a hunt around your house and write down as many objects as you can find.</p> <p>Challenge - Can you start to think about what materials these objects are made from?</p> <p>Here are some names of materials to remind you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Glass - Wood - Plastic - Metal - Fabric - Brick
Tuesday	<p>Over the next two weeks you are going to work towards writing a diary entry.</p>	<p>Write 3 different numbers down between 0 and 20 e.g. 17, 8 and 14. Discuss which is the greatest and which is the least. Put the numbers in order from smallest to largest.</p>	<p>Geography Today you are going to learn all about the countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom.</p>

See worksheet.</p> <p>Challenge- Can you tell an adult why a diary has a date or a time?</p> <p>Phonics- Complete the worksheet to help you recap the phase 3 sounds that we have learnt.</p> <p>Spellings- Learn to read and spell the phase 4 tricky words- little and one. Can you put these words into a sentence?</p>	<p>Repeat with different numbers. Wednesday	<p>Today you are going to complete a story map for the story ‘Katie in London’ which will help you with the order of your diary entry. Sequence the pictures on the story map by following the arrows.</p> <p>Use the story https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ImrNxcvC9bb4 to help you.</p>	<p>From today we are going to start adding and subtracting numbers to 20.</p> <p>Can you remember what the + and – symbols mean? Ask an adult to write you some calculations within 10 e.g. $6 + 3 =$, $8 - 4 =$. If you need to use some objects to help you can – maybe use pasta to count.</p> <p>Play mathopoly – see attachment.</p>	<p>PSHE Today you are going to learn all about how you grow and change as you get older.</p> <p>Watch the story ‘Once there were giants.’ https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=STwCfjVajys</p> <p>After watching, have a discussion with an adult about the changes to the baby in the story and link them to yourself.</p>

	<p>Challenge- Can you add some time connectives to help order the story. Some have been done for you.</p> <p>Phonics- Learn our new phonics sound- air, that's not fair. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zvq9bdm/articles/zj39382 Play Sound Sayer to practise reading air words. https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/soundSayer/index.html</p> <p>Spellings- Learn to read and spell the phase 4 tricky words- were and there. Can you put these words into a sentence?</p>		<p>Why does the baby call the adults giants? What new skills does the baby learn as she grows older? What changes have happened to you since you were a baby? How have your needs changed? What can you do now that you couldn't do before? Who helped you grow?</p>
Thursday	<p>Use the BBC Bitesize website and the PowerPoint to help you learn about using capital letters for names of people, places, days of the week and the personal pronoun I. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zrqqtfr/articles/zpd8ng8</p> <p>Complete the worksheet and correct the sentences, choosing which words should have a capital letter.</p> <p>Phonics- Read the story Clair at the funfair.</p>	<p>Use https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zknsgk7/articles/z3t94i6 to remind yourself about using a numberline. Make yourself a number line by writing down numbers 1-10. Practise using your numberline to count on and count back – e.g. start at 7 and count back 3 etc.</p> <p>Complete addition and subtraction numberline worksheet attached.</p>	<p>Our new topic – Bright lights, big city is all about London.</p> <p>See what facts you can find out about London. Watch the clip https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mBELEFMoktU to see what London looks like. Maybe you could find out facts about the Queen or one of the famous landmarks in London.</p>

	<p>Can you find all of the words with the 'air' sound in? What other sounds can you spot?</p> <p>Spellings- Learn to read and spell the phase 4 tricky words- what and when. Can you put these words into a sentence?</p>		
Friday	<p>Ready for your diary entry you need to find out a bit more about the London landmarks so you can write about them. Use the internet to help you research facts about some of the landmarks that appear in the story Katie in London.</p> <p>Now think about some adjectives that you could use to describe some of the landmarks and places.</p> <p>Phonics- Play buried treasure on Phonics Play https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/3/buried-treasure with air words. Can you sort the real and the alien words correctly?</p> <p>Spellings- Learn to read and spell the phase 4 tricky word out. Can you put these words into a sentence?</p>	<p>Today we will be adding by counting on. Remember that when you add you can add in any order so it's a good idea to put the largest number first.</p> <p>See White Rose home learning teaching video clip. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/week-2-number-addition-and-subtraction-within-20/ Look for first 2 clips add by counting on.</p> <p>Complete counting on worksheet attached.</p>	<p>RE This term we are continuing to focus on the religion Christianity and we will be learning about Weddings and Christenings.</p> <p>Watch https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/my-first-wedding to find out about a couple getting married.</p> <p>Discuss whether you have ever been to a wedding or do you know someone who has got married?
