Task one – investigate mixing primary colours. Those you make are secondary colours. We will be doing this by mixing paints at school. However, don’t worry if you don’t have paints at home. You could use food colouring in water, icing (and make 3 primary coloured cakes and three secondary coloured cakes – yum!), use chalks or just show the colours with crayons/felts on the provided sheet Task two – how would these colours be shown on a colour wheel?
