Monday	<p>Microsoft teams meeting at 9.45am.</p> <p>English Last week you planted your own bean seed and on Friday you sequenced the pictures on how to grow a bean plant.</p> <p>Today you are going to start writing your instructions on how to grow a bean plant, writing the title and the 'what you will need' list. Think about what you will need using the pictures from Friday to help you.</p> <p>Start writing your instructions on the attached sheet.</p> <p>Phonics- Play the phase 3 phoneme blast off game by following the instructions on the board.</p> <p>Spellings- Play the phase 3 tricky words snakes and ladders game. If you land on a tricky word, make sure you read it!</p>	<p>Maths This week we are beginning the unit on measuring length and height and today we will be comparing lengths and heights. Have a look around the house and compare different items e.g. the height of teddy bears, the length of pencils. Use the language tallest/taller shortest/shorter and longest/longer to compare.</p> <p>Watch https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/spring-week-8-measurement-length-and-height/ clip number 1 and 2 - compare lengths and heights activity.</p> <p>Cut out the attached monsters and order from shortest to tallest and the pencils from shortest to longest.</p>	<p>Science Today we are going to be naming common flowering plants.</p> <p>Watch the following clip to find out about plants that live outside. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zpxnyrd/articles/zw2y34j</p> <p>Go outside and find a flowering plant. Complete the sheet by drawing a picture of your plant or taking a photo of your plant, writing where you found it and find out its name.</p> <p>Complete the attached sheet by matching the names of the plants to the photos of the plants. When you are out and about see if you can spot any of these plants.</p>

	<p>Phonics- Read the phase 4 sentences and match them to the correct picture.</p> <p>Spellings- Have a go at spelling these phase 4 words - help, just, chimp, roast, pond, nest, milk.</p> <p>Now log onto Phonics Play using the username jan21 and the password home and choose the phase 4 option at the top of the screen. Play the game Space Race.</p>	<p>Have a go at measuring some things at home e.g. a book – how many paper clips or pasta or Lego bricks are the same length as the book? Make sure you line them up and don't leave any gaps.</p> <p>Complete the attached worksheet – measuring - non-standard units.</p>	<p>Have a go at completing these activities using an appropriate object (soft toy, ball, orange) to practise your underarm throw:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - With another person in your house, practise throwing the ball to each other using an underarm throw. How many passes can you make in 1 minute? How many passes can you make without dropping your object? - Place an object on the floor. Move two big steps away from the object. Using an underarm throw, see if you can hit the object that is on the floor. Now move back even further, can you hit the object this time? - Get a tub/bucket/box and place it on the floor. Move two big steps away from the tub/bucket/box. Using an underarm throw, see if you can get your object in the box.
