They can use apparatus such as counters, cubes etc. to build pictograms before they draw their own pictures. They need to be able to complete missing row or columns. They should use the same picture to represent all the data in the pictogram and line it up carefully. They should see pictograms vertically and horizontally.                      Questions to consider – How do you know how many images to draw? Which pictogram is easier to read?
